Fees

Lesson fees are payable *within 7 days* of receipt of invoice. Invoices are usually issued in the week leading up to the commencement of each term and are as follows:

\$30 per half hour lesson (total **\$300** for 10 week term) OR

\$60 per full hour lesson (total **\$600** for 10 week term)

Lessons are not offered during holiday periods.

Lesson cancellations

If a student is unable to attend a lesson for any reason and at least **24 hours notice** is received, Abbey Street Music will arrange a make up lesson for the student at a mutually agreed time for the student and teacher.

If for any reason the teacher is unavailable due to illness or unforeseen circumstances, Abbey Street Music will arrange a make up lesson for the student at a mutually agreed time for the student and teacher.

If advance notice is *not received*, the student will forfeit the lesson and no make up lesson will be offered.
